I have noted that Stafford Borough Council uploaded the above document on to the Examination library site on the 9th August.

As has been noted by others (Document P2-P15 for example) the Council continue to disregard the information provided on behalf of my client Hallam Land Management who are the party taking forward the development of the Stone SDL. This was set out clearly in Document P2 – 01b produced at the request of the Inspector to verify his Document MF-2. Further, verbal discussions were held and noted at the Examination over the realistic delivery rates including a 20% flexibility reduced tolerance (maximum 64 dpa). This of course extends the period of overall delivery by probably 2 years.

Would you please bring this anomaly to the attention of the Inspector, noting that this is the third time of offering of this information and the situation set out in Table 1 of Document P2-02a by the Council is still incorrect in relation to West Stone.
