C33 Local Government Reorganisation

Councillor A T A Godfrey presented the report setting out the potential options for Local Government Reorganisation in Staffordshire and proposed a single unitary council for southern and mid Staffordshire.

Councillor Godfrey proposed that Option A be the preferred option, which would be taken to Cabinet for consideration on 18 November.

This was seconded by Councillor R P Cooke who reserved his right to speak.

Councillors shared their concerns regarding the impact on staff and thanked the staff that had been involved with KPMG with the work carried out so far.

It was noted that work is progressing for the potential creation of Stafford Town Council to preserve some legacies of the council.
